## **Expectations of Campers**

At Gales Creek Camp, all children are important and have the right to feel safe. Respect for other campers, the staff and Gales Creek Camp is a MUST. Campers are expected to listen to the directions of the staff, cooperate in a group living environment and make safe and appropriate choices. Campers who choose to conduct themselves in a manner that negatively affects the other campers will lose camp privileges and may be sent home.

## **Head Lice**

All Campers will be checked for Head Lice during the Medical Check-In. If a Camper has head lice he will be instructed to return home to receive treatment and then will be allowed to return to camp to be checked back in.

## **Refund Policy**

- ❖ If you need to cancel your camp session, please notify the office five days in advance for a full refund of the deposit and fees. This gives the office enough time to fill that spot with someone on the waiting list.
- ❖ If you cancel on the day of registration Gales Creek Camp will not be able to refund any deposits or fees, as we cannot fill that spot on such short notice.
- ❖ If you need to leave camp early refunds will only be made based on medically related issues and will be pro-rated based on your length of stay at camp.

### **Please DO NOT Bring**

Boom Boxes,  
Cell Phones (They do not work at Camp)  
Sunscreen or Bug Spray (We Provide This)  
Skateboards  
Roller Blades  
Insulin, Glucose Monitors, Lancets or Syringes (We provide these supplies)  
Glucose Sensors  
Animals of any Kind

**Please do not bring your own diabetes supplies. We will provide all needed supplies except those related to Insulin Pumps and Pens.  
We do provide all Insulin for Pumps and Pens with the exception of Apidra.**

Items will be sent to the Camp Office and will be held until  
September 1, 2009 and then will be donated to Goodwill.**
