**Check-Out Date: Friday**

**12:00 Noon- All Campers Must be picked up**

### Expectations of Campers

At Gales Creek Camp, all children are important and have the right to feel safe. Respect for other campers, the staff and Gales Creek Camp is a MUST. Roller Blades  
Insulin, Glucose Monitors, Lancets or Syringes (We provide these supplies)  
Glucose Sensors
